# HOUSTON CAR ACCIDENT CHECKLIST

Involved in a car accident? Follow this checklist to make sure you are treated fairly and that your legal rights are protected.

## **Start Here:**

#### 1. Call 911 & Seek Medical Attention if Needed

- 🛞 Take note of your location (street name or highway sign) to provide to the operator.
- 🛞 Be aware that delaying treatment can make insurance coverage matters more difficult.

#### 2. Gather Information About the Accident

- \varepsilon The other driver's name address and telephone number.
- \varepsilon The driver's license number of the other person and license plate of the car that hit you.
- \varepsilon The name, address, and telephone number of any witnesses.
- 🕏 Photographs of the vehicles' resting place before they are moved and damage to both vehicles.
- Recording of any statements by the other driver admitting fault.

#### 3. Call the Police

- Police reports can help determine fault.
- The official crash report helps prevent the other side from changing their story.

#### 4. Notify Your Insurance Company

- \varepsilon Regardless of who was at fault, notify your insurance company immediately.
- \varepsilon Do not communicate with the opposing party's insurance company or release medical/employment
- \varepsilon or other records to them before speaking with your attorney.
- To not accept the insurance company's valuation of your claim without consulting your car accident attorney.

## Next Steps:

#### Assess Whether Medical Attention May Still Be Necessary

Even if injuries were not immediately apparent, seek medical attention right away if you experience stiffness or pain after the accident.

#### Obtain a Copy of the Accident Report

- 🛞 The accident report should be submitted to the Texas Department of Transportation within 10 days.
- Request your copy through the crash report online purchase system at https://www.txdot.gov/driver/ safety/crash-reports.html.
- 🛞 You will need specific information to file the request, including:
  - The names of the parties involved in the accident.
  - Date of the accident.
  - Location of the accident.
- The crash report costs \$6 for a regular copy and \$8 for a certified copy for a legal proceeding.
